CIVIL SERVICE GROOMING PROGRAMME

Kerala Region Latin Catholic Bishops Council (KRLCBC) Commissions for Youth & Education together with St. Albert's College (Autonomous), Ernakulam initiated full time residential degree level Civil Service Grooming Programme (CSGP) for male students in 2017. In 2018, St. Teresa's College (Autonomous), Ernakulam joins the programme for female candidates. CSGP aims at imparting effective and wholesome grooming to a select number of youth to successfully face the Civil Service Examination and other similar higher level examinations. Students who participate in the programme are able to pursue their degree level studies as well as orient themselves to prepare for the civil service examination with financial assistance from KRLCBC commissions (Youth and Education), individual dioceses, St. Albert's College (Autonomous) and St. Teresa's College (Autonomous), Ernakulam.

MISSION

To create in the students a positive, God-fearing and confident personality, which would empower them to withstand the modern educational, social and economic impediments and enable them to achieve the career of their interest.

GOAL

To impart effective and wholesome training to a select number of youth from the Roman Catholic (Latin) Dioceses of Kerala & a few seats reserved for tribal and dalit students from outside Kerala to successfully face the Civil Service and other similar examinations.

PARTICIPANTS

A group of 60 students, 4 (2 boys & 2 girls) each from Roman Catholic (Latin) Dioceses in Kerala and a few from the tribal and dalit areas outside Kerala, is chosen through a careful process after their Higher Secondary Studies. Selected students will take up a 3 year degree course of their choice in St. Albert's College (boys) and St. Teresa's College (girls). They will be given a three year intensive residential grooming for Civil Service, while they pursue their degree programmes.



FUNCTIONING OF THE PROGRAMME

- KRLCC coordinates the programme with the participation of Commission for Youth and Education.
- St Albert's College (Autonomous) and St. Teresa's College (Autonomous),
 Ernakulam host the programme.
- Each candidate selected for the programme will continue to be accountable to his/her parent diocese. The diocese in turn takes continued responsibility for each of its candidates.
- Being a residential training programme there will be a coordinator and two regent brothers for boys & a coordinator and two sisters for girls for academic equipping and to accompany the trainees during their field trips.
- It is an integrated training which covers academic, intellectual, emotional, socio-spiritual and community involvement dimensions.
- The programme envisages a formation involving different levels and hence strict adherence to a rigorous schedule is required. Strict discipline with enough space for personal freedom and aspirations, as well as room for mature mutual dialogue will be expected.
- Being a fulltime residential programme, evening library hours, training sessions, extended hours of lab facility, weekend special programme plus Sunday exposure, will be arranged regularly.



ELIGIBLITY & REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Above 75% marks in Plus Two.
- 2. Successfully clearing the selection process.
- 3. Merit based Admission in the colleges in General/ Community/ Management Quota.
- 4. A letter from the Diocesan Bishop.
- 5. Completed Catechism upto Plus Two.

EXPENSES OF THE PROGRAMME

The total cost per student will be ₹1,30,000/ annually, which will cover boarding, lodging, college fee for aided courses, training costs, library and materials and expenses for training related travels. The selected students will be offered a subsidy of 70% of the total costs. Hence each student will be charged only ₹40,000/- each year. The Diocese, KRLCC and the host institution will share the remaining amount. Medical expenses, additional fees if they join for self financing courses and other unexpected expenses will be extra. The total costs per student will be ₹1,30,000/- annually, which will cover boarding and lodging, college fee for aided courses, training costs, library and materials and expenses for training related travels. Medical expenses, additional fees if they join for self-financing courses and other unexpected expenses will be extra. The selected students will be offered a subsidy of nearly 70% of the total costs. Hence each student will be charged only ₹40,000/- each year. The diocese will provide ₹40,000/- and the host institution will provide ₹40,000/- for each student each year as scholarship. KRLCC will provide a scholarship of ₹10,000/- for each student each year.
